



## Donald Bennett Harrell

It is with profound sadness, we announce the passing of Donald (Donnie) Bennett Harrell, 66, of Merritt. On Sunday, Aug. 4th, Donnie left us earthside, losing his courageous battle with cancer. Born Aug. 7th, 1957, to William and Darlene Harrell, who preceded him in death. Donnie married Rose Marie McEuen on Aug. 28, 1977, and she survives.
