Edward LeRoy Haggard, 85, of Winchester passed away Monday, Sept. 2, 2013 at Passavant Area Hospital in Jacksonville . He was born April 14, 1928 in Jacksonville , the son of Vernon V. and Margaret I. Wild Haggard. He married Evelyn Evans July 18, 1948 in Winchester .

Surviving is his wife, Evelyn of Winchester; daughters, Priscilla “Susie” Haggard of Winchester and Mary (husband, Lloyd) Boes of Riverton; grandchildren, Eric Boes of LasVagas , NV , Trevor Boes (companion Beckie Olds) of Moore , OK , and Leah Boes of Springfield . Edward was an Army veteran. He was deployed to Korea during the Korean Conflict, serving in the armored tank division. After leaving the utility department, Ed worked for the Illinois Commerce Commission as a pipeline safety inspector. Ed, was a long time member and fire chief of the Winchester Fire Dept. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Winchester. He was also a member of the American Legion for 50 years and the Masonic Lodge.
