Evelyn F. Lonergan, 93, of Jacksonville and formerly of Murrayville passed away Wednesday, Feb. 26, 2014 at Heritage Health in Jacksonville. She was born April 19, 1920 in Decatur, the daughter of Bernard Jacob and Florence Marie Appenzeller Brinkoetter. She married Vincent J. Lonergan April 28, 1943 in Decatur. He preceded her in death Oct. 31, 1987.

Surviving are three children, Joyce (Bill) Clancy of Jacksonville, Mary Evelyn (Steve) Engelbrecht of Murrayville, and Michael (Linda) Lonergan of Jacksonville; seven grandchildren, Craig (Clare) Clancy of Godfrey, David (Kristin) Clancy of Jacksonville, Fr.
