Everett Wilson Bowers, 93, of Roodhouse, Illinois, died October 18, 2013 at the Jerseyville Community Hospital in Jerseyville after a short illness.

He was born April 3, 1920 to Orville Glenton and Lydia Rowden Bowers in Jersey County, Illinois. Mr. Bowers worked for many years for the Allis-Chalmers Manufacturing Company.

He was married August 23, 1947 in Pocahontas, Arkansas to Catherine Abbie Ryder, who survives.
