Floyd G. Boston, 91, of White Hall, and formerly of the Manchester area, died Tuesday, June 15, 2010, at Passavant Area Hospital in Jacksonville.

He was born Jan. 1, 1919, in Manchester, the son of Oscar Bruce and Josephine Akers Boston.
