Jack Dee Barnett, 83, of Bluffs went to be with his Lord Tuesday, Oct. 11, 2016, at the Jacksonville Skilled Nursing Center after a long extended illness. He was born, Aug. 27, 1933, in Alsey, the son of Robert Greene and Thelma Day Barnett. He married Terrell Jean Lorton, Dec. 26, 1954, in White Hall. She survives in Bluffs.
