Mark A. Tiemann, 67, of Jacksonville met his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, May 6, 2024, at his residence. He was born Feb. 28, 1957, in Jacksonville, the son of Byron and Jeanne Rex Tiemann. He married Monica Bishop, May 3, 2000.

Mark, a decorated Triopia High School athlete, caught the first touchdown in the school's first ever IHSA football championship game. He is enshrined in the Illinois College Hall of Fame as part of the 1978 football team who finished 8-1 and was recognized as All-District in '78 & '79. Mark served honorably in the US Army from '84-'86 as a Corporal before being medically retired. He later managed several local taverns and owned his own, Tiemann's Speak Easy, for several years. His business was people and always found the

greatest joy in getting to know someone. The NFL Playoffs were one of his favorite times of the year, where it was mandatory for the family to gather and celebrate with food, fun, and football. Mark, a known storyteller, could always spin a vibrant tale that left you wondering if it were fact or fiction - a fine man that blessed us with many a fine memory. Mark Tiemann – Husband, Father, Paps, Uncle, Brother, Friend, and Christian – cherished, above all else, his wife, children, and grandchildren. He left indelible marks on all those he touched, leaving behind a legacy that will be carried far and wide.
