Mary Jane Rudd Rimbey, 85, passed away Thursday, November 29, 2012 at the Heritage Health Care in Jacksonville. Jane was born July 18, 1927 in Decatur; the daughter of Alfred Clayton Sr and Estella Jane Pollock Rudd. She married Hardin Lee Rimbey November 28, 1948 in Jacksonville. He preceded her in death February 22, 1977.

Surviving are two daughters, Peggy (William) Zachary Jr. of Jacksonville, Linda (Christopher) Wheal of Riverton; two sons, Fred (Deborah) Rimbey of Longmont, CO and Cliff (Debbie) Rimbey of Boulder, CO; three grandchildren, Amy (Lance) Reynolds of Springfield, Joshua Wheal of Missoula, MT, and Sarah (Joe) Hunt of Batavia, IL; and twin great-grandchildren, Stella and Zachary Reynolds. baker. Jane dedicated her life to her family, nursing, and friends.
