Michael Dean Hutton, 75, of Barry, Illinois, passed away on July 8, 2025, at Southeast Iowa Regional Medical Center in West Burlington, Iowa. Born on February 22, 1950, in Bluffs, Illinois, Mike was the son of Lloyd Dean Hutton and Phyllis Hutton Van-Hyning.

Mike was a proud veteran of the U.S. Army, having served during the Vietnam War in a 36-man artillery battery. His service was marked by bravery and dedication, and he carried deep pride in having served his country.

A man of many talents, Mike was particularly known as a gifted musician and artist. In his youth, he co-founded several local bands, including The Marauders, Joyelegg, and Hotwire, captivating audiences with rock music across the Midwest. Known for his smooth vocals and the ability to perform nearly any song flawlessly, Mike made a significant impact on both audiences and fellow musicians. Although he eventually stepped back from performing due to health challenges, his passion for music remained a constant throughout his life.

In addition to his musical talent, Mike was a skilled craftsman. He created beautiful wood mosaic wall art, custom furniture, watercolor, and acrylic paintings. His mountain scenes, chairs, and cabinets were widely admired and continue to be appreciated online. Mike devoted himself to his craft, taking

great pride in the beauty he was able to create.

Mike is survived by his longtime partner, Patty Fowler; his daughter, Elaina (Tyler) Finnie; and his grandchildren, Taylor, Reece, and Chandler. He is also survived by his father, Lloyd Dean Hutton. He was preceded in death by his mother, Phyllis Van-Hyning; two brothers, Timothy and Randy Hutton; and his sister, Nancy Hutton.
