Philip Francis Snow, Sr. passed away March 8, 2018. He was born on June 4, 1924 in Palmyra, New Jersey. Upon graduation from high school he was called to service. Phil was assigned to the 17th Airborne Division 193 Glider Infantry Regiment where he served through VE Day. He saw action in the Battle of the Bulge Operation victory and the follow up advance into Germany for which he was awarded the Bronze Star. After VE Day he was transferred to the 82nd Airborne Division as part of the occupation force. After returning from the war, he attended Illinois College and graduated in 1949. Phil was hardworking, honest, direct and dedicated. He was a man of strong convictions regarding life, his country and his God. Over the years he successfully worked his way up the corporate ladder. Ultimately, at the time of retirement, having served as president, chief operating officer and director of several companies.
