



## Richard D. "Dick" Coon

February 7, 1942 - October 8, 2017

Richard D. "Dick" Coon, 75, lifelong resident of Winchester, died Sunday, Oct. 8, 2017, at the Scott County Nursing Center in Winchester. He was born, Feb. 7, 1942, at Illini Hospital in Pittsfield, the oldest son of Robert and Geraldine Coultas Coon. He married Sandra Oakes. They later divorced.
