Richard L. Jackson, 78, of Virginia was called home to be with his savior Sunday, May 20, 2018. He passed peacefully at home with his wife of 53 years by his side. Richard was born, May 30, 1939, in Jacksonville, the son of Raymond and Gladys McDaniel Jackson. He married Linda Lisenbee, June 21, 1964, in Jacksonville. She survives in Virginia.

To this union they were blessed with surviving children, Richard Aaron (Christina) Jackson of Virginia and Dawna Lynn (Steve) King of Jacksonville. He was a grandpa to TSgt. He was a 50-year member of IBEW Local

He enjoyed reading, music, poetry, learning and teaching others about many subjects. He loved to attend auctions to find treasures like old cars, tractors and bibles. Richard was an avid Illini Basketball fan and Chicago Bears fan.
