Robert Wayne Dahman, 93, was born Oct. 11, 1929, at the old Passavant Hospital in Jacksonville, IL, the son of Russell & Donna Carlton Dahman. Bob married Betty Coates in June of 1948. He later married, Barbara Foreman Buckley in June 1983.

Surviving are two sons, Michael (wife, Brenda) and Bruce (wife, Pamela) both of rural Winchester, 3 grandchildren, Andrew (Mandie) and Matthew of Winchester, Michelle (Richard) Seymour of Glen Carbon; 6 great grandchildren, Zachary Dahman, Chloe Dahman, Jackson Dahman, Keira Dahman, all of Winchester, Alexis Seymour & Bryce Seymour of Glen Carbon, II. He is survived by his sister, Rosalie (Mike) Fiedler of Winchester. Three stepchildren, Anita Arigona, Clint Buckley, and James Buckley. He was preceded in death by his parents and his wife, Barbara.

Bob was a 1948 graduate of Winchester High School. He was involved in farming for most of his adult life. He served as a Corporal in the US Army, from 1952-1954, in the 45th Infantry Division and MPs in Korea. He received the Korean Service Ribbon with 2 Bronze Stars, National Defense Service Medal, and Korean War Service Medal.

Following his military service, he resumed farming. In 1963 he opened Dahman Equipment Inc., selling International Harvester Farm Equipment until his retirement. He was a member of the Winchester First Christian Church, Winchester American Legion Post 442, Winchester VFW, Scott County Historical Society, and Jacksonville Area Genealogical and Historical Society. He was a die-hard Cubs fan, collecting toy farm machinery and ball caps. He was an avid traveler around the United States and many countries overseas. He was continuously interested in his farms and devoted to his family, especially his grandchildren and great grandchildren.
