Robert Warren Young, 45, of Manchester died Sunday, Oct. 7, 2018, at his home after a courageous 2 ½ year battle with cancer. Bob was born, Aug. 30, 1973, the son of Claude Richard and Emily Ann Coultas Young of Manchester.
