Roy Lawrence VanBebber, 83, of Murrayville passed away Monday, May 23, 2011 at the Jacksonville Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Jacksonville. He was born Oct. 9, 1927 in Nortonville, the son of Verner and Mary Lois Spencer VanBebber. He married Allene Darrah April 14, 1954 in Sterling, KS. She preceded him in death May 18, 2004.
