She was born, Oct. 21, 1965, in Jacksonville, the daughter of Rev. William and Anna Belle “Ann” Starner Newingham. Teresa married Lyndell Huseman, Sept. 14, 1985, in Jacksonville.

Surviving is her husband, Lyndell of Bluffs; four children, Derek (wife, Anissa) of Chapin, Amanda (companion, Jordan Goldsborough) of Jacksonville, Raychel of Hannibal, MO, and Ericka at home; mother, Ann Newingham of Jacksonville; brothers, Randall (wife, Sarah) Newingham of Waverly, Kevin (wife, Julianna) Newingham of Ft.
