Terry Lynn Denison of Jacksonville, age 78, peacefully passed away Friday, December 1, 2023, at Jacksonville Memorial Hospital. He was born on October 13, 1945, in Pittsfield. He was the youngest son of Lyndle and Irene (Graham) Denison.

Surviving is his wife, Cassie L.
