Todd Alan Rodgers, 31, of Winchester died of natural causes Sunday, July 4, 2010, at the Passavant Hospital in Jacksonville. He was born Nov. 19, 1978 in Florissant, MO, the son of Robert and Alice Draper Rodgers.

Surviving are his mother, Alice and brother, Scott Rodgers both of Winchester; two half brothers, David M. Draper of Hurricane, Utah and John J. Millican of St. Louis, MO.

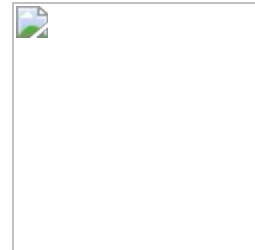
