Vincent Ray Reagor, 86, of Roodhouse, died July 4, 2016. He was born, November 25, 1929, in Roodhouse, the son of William Eli and Amanda Smith Reagor. He married Rose Marian Cannedy, February 17, 1949. She preceded him in death, February 22, 1994. He later married Muriel Dean, March 12, 1996. She preceded him in death, May 7, 2008.
