Warren R. Lovelace, 86, of Quincy went home to be with the Lord Sunday, Feb. 22, 2015, at the Illinois Veterans' Home in Quincy. He was born, Sept. 22, 1928, near Patterson, the son of Burley and Mabel Bryant Lovelace. He married Edna Louise Arnold, June 30, 1950, at Pinckneyville, IL.

Surviving is his wife, Edna of Quincy; children, Sheryl Bryan of Quincy, Beverly (Kerry) Hirtzel of Shumway, and Carol (Richard) Foster of Huntsville, AL; six grandchildren; and six great grandchildren. Warren was preceded in death by a sister, Mary Raabe and son-in-law, Roger Bryan.
