William Burnett Harrell, 91, of Jacksonville passed away Sunday July 10, 2011 at the Barton W. Stone Nursing Home in Jacksonville. He was born July 28, 1919 in Fishhook, IL, the son of John Sherman and Jennie Maude Carter Harrell. He married Darlene Grady Oct. 29, 1949 in Winchester. She survives in Jacksonville.
